- Supporting clients with their assigned readings and assignments on recovery from an eating disorder
- Attendance at multidisciplinary team meetings and weekly supervision
- Help with some administrative tasks (e.g. client individual schedules, clinic white board notices, photocopies for client materials, buying materials for activities etc.)
- Writing short daily notes to communicate client progress with the team

- Excellent organization skills, can prioritize tasks and work well under pressure
- Able to evaluate and intervene with a client in crisis
- Knowledge of mental health and appropriate intervention strategies
- Passion for working as part of a team and in group settings

- Experience working with people with mental health issues
- Excellent written and spoken French and English
- Excellent interpersonal skills
- Experience working with food or in a restaurant setting would be a plus
